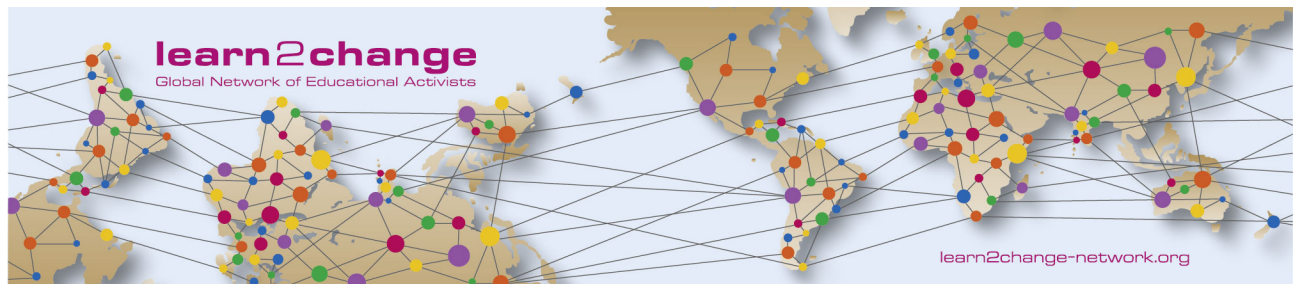
Sisir Dutta, Bangladesh

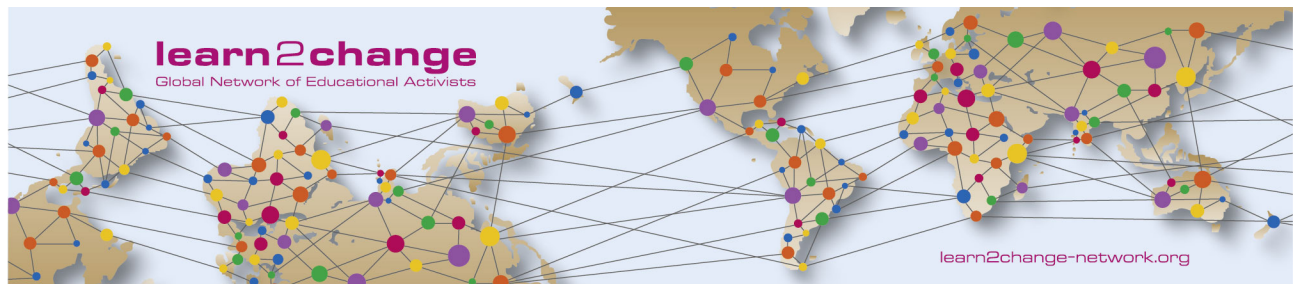
Preeti Oza, Indien
