The war in Sudan

Information, discussion and reflection of the actual situation in the country

29 August 2024, 3:00 – 5:00 pm CET+1, Online event in English via Zoom

While many of us are busy with the situation of war in Ukraine and the conflict in the middle east, we witness a forgotten humanitarian crisis in Sudan. The situation is deteriorating rapidly there with almost no media coverage or political attention. More than one year after war erupted between the Sudanese Armed Forces (SAF) and the Rapid Support Forces (RSF) on 15 April 2023, Sudan is facing one of the fastest unfolding crises globally, with unprecedented needs. More than 15,600 people have been killed and more than 33,000 injured. About 25 million people need humanitarian assistance and support. Alarmingly 17.7 million people are facing acute food insecurity under a warning of potential famine. More than 8.6 million people have fled their homes since the conflict started. They have sought refuge within Sudan or in neighboring countries, making Sudan the largest displacement crisis in the world."

What are the latest developments there in Sudan? What are the impacts on democracy, but also on sustainability in the country? What are the efforts of the civilian and democratic forces in Sudan to stop war? How can we impact the situation there? During this Online Talk, we can hear from and talk with **Maissara Saeed, Umbaja e. V.** about the situation in Sudan. Maissara is from Sudan, lives in Germany since many years and is active in the fields of education, empowerment, and advocacy for a democratic and sustainable change in Sudan, but also worldwide. He is founding member of Learn2Change.
